Thursday November The 3^d 1864,

Commenced

With light-variable and pleasant weather
Finished boiling at 3 Pm the far turner up

Fri 4th

This day light-variable air and pleasant
Weather. Employed at cooking the oil

Sat 5th

Commenced with light & variable wind with
Rainy weather at daylight broke out
After hatch for provision at 12 kept
off at sundown luffed and
Took in light-sails

Sun 6th

Commenced with light air and pleasant
Weather. Ship steering N. one sail in
Light-called the Sealman

Mon 7th

Commenced with light-variable wind
and pleasant weather, at daylight
Commenced stowing down side in after
Hatch aboard-chain pen

Tuesday November The 8th 1864

This day

Calm and rainy weather employed at
Washing ship, at sun down took in light

Wed 9th

Commenced with a calm, at 10 a m had a
Light breeze from the S. Steered N at 3 Pm
Luffed to the wind on the off shore tack
Landed about 10 miles off (Latta)

Thurs 10th

Light-variable wind and pleasant weather
Employed at ship duty

Fri 11th

This day pleasant weather with light wind
Employed through the day in setting up
the fore rigging.

Sat 12th

This day light wind from W. employed
in the fore rigging.

Sun 13th

Winds S. and light steering N.N.W. one
Sail in sight at sundown luffed to wind
And took in light-sails.
