Tuesday December the 13th 1864.

Commenced with
Light winds from N.W. ship by the wind on
Port tack. the island of Mathian bearing
N.E. distance 25 miles men engaged.
Through the day at Ship duty.

Wednesday 14th

This day commences with a moderate wind
from N.W. and continued so through the
day, current setting N. at sundown the
Island of Marselans in sight bearing N.E.
Distance 20 miles nothing more worthy of note.

Thursday 15th

This day commences with a moderate variable
wind from S.W. to W.N.W. with frequent
showers of rain, the island of Latta in sight
bearing E.N.E. dist 25 miles, saw one S. Hare.

Friday 16th

This day moderate wind from the S. ship
steering W.S.W. hove to for Grey Hound Strait
Current setting to the N. at little being
On the decrease of the moon employed
At Ship duty. The day is cloudy.

Wednesday December the 17th 1864

This day begins
With pleasant weather and light wind from
North steering S.W. by W. saw a number of
White water cattle. Gram puses by our side
Captain at sundown the island of
Mangola bearing South distance 35 miles

This day comes in with a nice breeze from S.W.
steering for Grey Hound Strait at 11.20
A.M. raised a school of whales going to the West
Lowered her called them. Water Boat
Darted but did not strike at sundown
Grey Hound Strait bearing W.N.W. 18 miles

Monday 19th

This day commences with pleasant weather with
light air from N. by E. ship cruising for a day
On so in the Grey Hound passage for at the mouth
Of it at sundown the Strait bearing W.S.W. 25
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
