Tuesday, March the 28th 1865

This day a nice

Breeze from W. ship of the South side of
Marble Sound to the Eastward, at daylight
saw the island of Kulla Bessy, saw Black
Wid

Wed 29th

This day comes in calm and hot at daylight
the ship at the mouth of Pitts Passage the
Island of Bruno in sight bearing S.E.
Men employed at scraping the ships copper
And the Chains around the dead eyes, at
Lun down Kulla Bessy bearing W. N. W. dist 15
miles

Thurs 30th

This day light air and calms. ship moving to
the Eastward, men employed at scraping iron
Work as usual at sundown light air from
S.W. Lissamattula bearing N.E. dist 20 miles

Fri 31st

This day strong wind from N.W. at day
Light saw Sea Lull standing in towards Lissamattula
Saw Fin Back, at sundown Batokian in sight
Bearing N.E. distance 40 miles.

Saturday April the 1st 1865

Commenced with

Pleasant weather light variable wind saw
Fin Back, saw the sea Lull, at sundown
Batokian bearing E. dist 35 miles,

Lun 2nd

This day fine pleasant weather a nice breeze
from N.W. at day light kept the ship
Off and steered S.E. until we spoke the
Sea Lull, then steered E. S. E. at sundown
Between Taba and Batokian bound in
to Pitts Passage on our way to St. David's
Island.

Mon 3rd

This day light air from N.W. we on our
way for David Island, at sundown
saw the report of sound up the Pitts Pass

Tues 4th

This day a calm but the current being
in our favor we made good headway
saw in sight carrier main say
All day
