Sunday July The 2nd 1865
This day fine pleasant
Weather, at day Osceola in sight, at
Sun down gained with her again

Mon 3rd
This day moderate wind & pleasant weather.
Men employed at cutting and fitting
Fore Top Gallant sail

Tue 4th
This day strong wind but pleasant
Saw two sails at sun down reefed 7th
Top sail,

Wed 5th
This day nice pleasant weather moderate breeze
At daylight sent down main sail for repair
At 4 P.M. sent it up again Osceola &
Sea Queen in sight - during the day of Latte

Off Latta Molucca Passage / Beating up the molucca.
On our way home

Thursday July The 6th 1865
This day pleasant - a
fine breeze at daylight - lashing the
wheel to repair it and prepared it to
vanish at 4 O'clock - then it again
Sea Queen & Osceola in sight during the

Frid 7th
This day comes in with pleasant weather and
moderate winds, men employed at cleaning
Blocks, Osceola, and Sea Queen passed by to the
Off us, at sun down City Major bearing S by E
Distance of 50 miles

Sat 8th
This day commences with moderate winds and
pleasant - ship beating up the molucca passage
Trung to get into the Pitts passage, at 9 O'clock
At 11, Osceola passed by us to Leonard, so ends.
