Friday Aug 3^d

This day comes in pleasant with light air from the S.E. course 10th the people variously employed in wind with weather continues the same at noon 3rd of water in fore & aft. Dist about 15 miles saw several sail thus ends

Remarks

Saturday Aug 4th
Comes in fine and light air from N.W. at 7 with the men end of 3rd of water bearing S by N Dist about 15 miles. The bluff head of Seal harbor bearing E. Dist about 10 miles. Tacked ship to the S.W. with fair at 7 to reach N.W. at noon the best point of Seal bore S by E Dist about 12 miles thus ends with pinning

Remarks

Sunday Aug 5th

This day comes in with fresh breeze from S.W. at one P.M. in S.E. sails and by 4 P.M. & steered S.E. at 5 P.M. called to the at 4 N. double reefed 3 sails and hauled the course at 7 P.M. in 3rd of water. weather squally and rains. Am fair with fresh breeze from the W. ward set all sail and steered towards the S.E. at 9 P.M. S.E. cruising

The ship's log increasing a little in rough weather the last 24 hours recked about 2000 strokes. at noon the island of Graciosa bore E.S.E. per compass

Remarks

Monday Aug 6th 1855

This day comes in fair with light breeze from the N. Steering to the S.W. at 2 P.M. the island of Graciosa bore S by E. Dist about 20 miles. at sundown shortened sail Am. calm ship laying with the 3 sails on the cap no sail set and leaking 35 strokes per hour thus ends this day Graciosa bearing South 15 miles Dist 7

29 Tuesday Aug 7th 1855

Comes in pleasant and calm laying with one topsail on the cap Graciosa about 15 miles Dist Am at 7 P.M. light air from the S.W. saw 3 men in the rigging in receiving new canvas and setting up the fore rigging thus ends this day

Wednesday Aug 8th
Comes in fine with light breeze from the S.W. at 2 P.M. raised 3 sails to the windward of the ship about 3 miles at 3 P.M. lowered three to pull up to see what they were & they proved to be a gam of large sperm whales. whales struck and got line to the S. Boat took him along side about dark & shortened sail. at 4 P.M. called all hands to cut 5th saw 3 whales lowered and got one to the S. Boat. took him along side about 10 P.M. thus ends this day with the boat in chase. Bore bearing South about 30 miles Dist
