Thursday, 9th 1855

Pm comes in fine and light winds
all the Deck on the crane. we hooked in
cut in one whale. A French Barge put
close to us heading to the S. Ward
Am at 8.30 started fires for boiling
about 7.30. began to cut the 2nd whale
thus continues in cutting & boiling

Friday Aug 10th

Pm fine weather finished cutting
and took in one head Am taking in
the 2d one saw grampuses thus
continues this day with all hands
employed in taking care of oil

Long by Chron. 22.50 W

Saturday Aug 11th

This 24 hours pleasant weather
with light breezes Ship under
easy sail all hands employed
in taking care of oil saw several
sail and grampuses
thus ends this 24 hours

Sunday Aug 12th 1855

Pm fair weather with light breezes
from the W. Ward Ship heading S. Ward
all hands employed in taking care
of oil Am continues the the same
saw several sail and a plenty
of grampuses thus ends this day

Monday Aug 13th

Comes in fair with light breezes
from the W. & W. all hands employed
in taking care of oil saw Graciosa
at 4.30. Ship to the N. at 2.30 Am
raining and to cool down the try works
about 8.30 started fires again at noon
finished boiling except the lean
oil

Remarks

Tuesday Aug 14th

This day fine weather with light
winds from the W. Ward oil all turned
up 115 Bbls. people employed in
cleaning Ship. Cooper tapped up with
a bad sore finger. Saw a ship
steering to the W. Ward
thus Graciosa about 12.30 dist
bearing W. S. thus ends
