Tuesday Aug 28th 1855

This day begins fair with fresh breezes from N.W. Ship heading to the N.E. at sundown shortened sail wind N.E. Am made sail wind light and lifting people variously employed at noon Graciosa bore W by N compass dist 12 miles thus ends this day.

Wednesday Aug 29th

Comes in calm at 8 light fair from S.E. steered N.W. at sundown shortened sail at 4 wind west steered N. Am continues fine pleasant weather ship with all sail out people employed variously thus ends

Thursday Aug 30th

Comes in fine wind N.W. Ship heading to the N. at sundown shortened sail no fresh breezes and cloudy at 10 wind from the N. squared in & steered South thus continues. Lat by obs 40.10 N

Remarks

Friday Aug 31st

This day comes in with strong breeze from N. steering S. at one P.M. double reefed and in the sail and jib at 3. rain at 4. saw a Brig heading E. at 5 in fine sail and wore ship to the N. Am fresh gales from S.E. & thick rainy weather at 8 wore ship to the S. at 11 set the foresail & double reefed E. sail thus continues this day.

Remarks

Saturday Sept. 1st 1855

This day comes in with strong breezes from E.N.E. and thick weather ship under short sail steering South at 5 P.M. saw the north end of Becharia bearing S by W and Graciosa bearing W by N per compass were ships to the N. Am wore moderate ship heading to the S. under topsails & courses saw grampuses thus ends ship looking as formerly.

Remarks

Sunday Sept 2^d

Comes in with cloudy weather wind from the E. ward. saw Becharia and Graciosa at 7 shortened sail & wore ship to the N. Am a little more moderate at 8 backed toward the South saw a sail at 9 steered it N at 11. Am thus continues with cloudy weather so obs Graciosa bearing S by E about 18 miles.

Monday Sept 3^d

Comes in with cloudy weather and moderate breezes from the E. ward ship heading toward the N. Am continues fine with light breezes at 8 backed to the S. set all sail at noon Graciosa bore S by W dist 20 miles.

Tuesday Sept 4th

Comes in with fine pleasant weather and light airs ship with all sail out heading to the N. at sundown in sails saw a sail Am made sail light airs from the E. ward saw several sail and grampuses people employed variously thus ends
