Wednesday Sept 5th 1858

This day comes in pleasant with air from N.E. at sundown shortened sail. Am. continues pleasant & calm. The blacksmiths employed in various jobs at blacksmithing. Sent down the S. & S. sail to repair this continues this day. Ship heading S. per compass. Lat by Obs 39.55 N

Remarks

Thursday Sept 6th

Comes in pleasant and calm. Implied in breaking out for water bread &c. four sails in sight sent up the fore & sail at a light breeze from the N. ward at sundown shortened sail. steering E. Am. continues pleasant set all sail & steered S.E. & sail in sight thus continuing people variously employed blacksmith at the forge

Lat by Obs 39.40 N

Friday Sept 7th

The fore part pleasant with light breezes from the N. ward steered S.E. at sundown shortened sail Am. fine set all sail light breeze from N.E. saw grampuses and two sail. blacksmiths employed at the forge people employed abundantly at men Graciosa bearing S by W

Remarks

Saturday 8th Sept 1858

This day comes in fine with light breezes from the E. ward saw two sail at sundown shortened sail Am. continues fair two sail in sight saw grampuses people employed in washing this continues this day Ship heading E. ward Graciosa bearing S by W

Remarks

Sunday Sept 9th

The fore part air and light breezes from E.S.E. Ship heading towards the N.E. at sundown shortened sail Am. continues fine with light air from the S. Ship towards the N. ward two sail in sight at noon Graciosa bearing S by S. Dist about 20 miles

Remarks

Monday Sept 10th

Comes in pleasant and light air from the S. at 1 hr. backed to the E. ward ship under all sail at sundown shortened sail one sail in sight Am. fine at sunrise set all sail 7 sail in sight all merchant men

employed in stripping and refitting the rig jib boom shortening the mainmast stays and various other jobs. thus ends this day Graciosa bearing S.E. Dist about 14 miles

Remarks

Tuesday Sept 11th

The fore part fine with light breezes from S.E. Ship heading S.W. 2 sail in sight. Am. continues fine at sunrise set all sail. Ship heading to the westward 9 sail in sight saw grampuses people employed in getting out water and various other duties. Hyal. Pico St George Graciosa and Beana all in sight this end. Lat 39.15 N
