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Hours	Course winds	Wednesday Oct 10 th
2	NW WSW	This 24 hours comes in fine with light breezes at 4 PM calm ship about 8 miles off shore down & boats to tow of at 1/2 past 4 light breeze from NW called the boats alongside & took them up at 5 o'clock. at 8 o'clock again the crew several times through the night at 8 AM Capt. Tucker went on shore at 10 AM began taking at Drava. but this would not let him label the post was shut up Capt. returned on board & steered off to the South this ends this day

2	S E	These 24 hours comes in fine with light breezes from E. W. set topmast & top galant shrouding sails Am. continues the the same people variously employed blacksmith at the forge & this ends Set by Obs 13.47 N
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Hours	Course winds	Friday Oct 12 th
2	SE E	The fore part fine with light airs ship with all sails set Am. continues much the same saw Dargue heading N. W. our people regularly employed Set by Obs 13 13.5
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Hours	Course winds	Saturday Oct 13 th
2	SE E N E	comes in with fine and weather and light breezes all sails set that will draw Am. continues pleasant with light breezes ship with all sails out saw A finback ship looking as usual Set by Obs 14.55 N
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Hours	Course winds	Sunday Oct 14 th
2	SE E N E	comes in fine and light winds ship with all sail out the middle part sharp flashes of lightning and dist. thunder Am. light breeze & weather looking squally at 9 in light sails. clench down for 1 sail and up one sail and quite a heavy squall from S. E. with rain at 10 PM set all sail again except studding sails it now clouds more broken saw the sun Set by Obs 10.30 N
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
