Thursday 13th

Comes in with fair weather and fresh breezes from N at 3 tacked to the N.W. at 3 Am tacked again to the S.E. shortened sail and at 4 commenced breaking out to stow oil. found one of the ground casks stove and it was done at home when the ship was stowed. saw finbacks thus ends this day

Lat by Obs 38.51 S.

Friday Dec 14th

Comes in with cloudy and drizzly weather winds South at 7 Am had the oil down and every thing stowed away at 8 tacked ship to S.S.W. wind light. Am tacked several times winds light and hoisting an squally thus continues

Lat by Obs 38.53 S

Saturday Dec 15th

Begins fair with light breezes from S.S.E. ship heading E. ward all sail out at 1 Am tacked to S.W. at 8 wind S.E. saw finbacks & blackfish thus continues. Lat by Obs 39.07 S. Long then 19.38 E

Sunday Dec 16th

The fore part fair with light breezes from S.E. am from E at 10 am fore topmast studding sail steered S by E per compass 24 pts variation westerly one sail in sight. ends Lat by Obs 38.37 S

Monday Dec 17th

Comes in fine with light breezes from E. ward 6 in E. S. mast studding sail. at 9 steering S.E. wind E.S.E. Am calm people variously employed

Lat by Obs 39.18 S

Tuesday Dec 18th

Comes in fine at 3 light breezes from S.W. steering S.E. set studding sails blow on left saw 4 whale ship heading E. ward at 9 wind NW at 11 NW in cover studding sail Am wind increasing 10 in studding sails and topgallant sails & fly jib thus continues neither clear people employed variously saw finbacks

Wednesday Dec 19th

The fore part strong breezes from S.W. with fair weather steering S.E. per compass variation 24 pts westerly at 3 set main top gal sail Middle Light - Winds from N steering S.E. as said latter fresh breezes from N.W. steering S.E. as said at 9 A.M. saw right Whales the topmast stuck and the whale stuck. the boat and held the office

Came with strong breezes from N.W. in fog in Whaling at 2.30 took the whale a long time. Lugga corn meat cutting. Had a bad weather day. Lat by Obs 40.00 S
