Thurs May 13th

Came with moderate breeze from the
S.W. W. laying under short sail
ship laying up S.E. employed in
boiling at sunset set the watch
middle and latter part much the
same at daylight wind out of S.W.
steered E. by N. under easy sail and
wind increasing nothing in sight

Frid May 14th

Came with fresh breeze and increasing
from the S.W. course E. by S. employed
in boiling at sunset blowing a light
gale and squally at midnight wind
abated somewhat we slipped to the
wind laying up S. with a heavy swell
from the S.W. middle part blowing
a moderate gale from the W. ship laying
up to the S. with latter part scudding
under close reef in top sail and foresail
and boiling nothing in sight course
to the N.E.

Sat May 15th

Came with a fresh gale from the W. ship
scudding under short sail and under close
reef. The top sail and foresail with squalls
at intervals at three P.M. it blowing a
fresh gale and increasing pushed the ship
at sunset set the watch at midnight there
the ship to being unable to coil coiled
down the works ship laying up N. by W.
and heeled the foresail middle and
latter part much the same the ship laboring
very and the latter evening

Sun May 13th

Came with a heavy gale with a tremendous sea
running ship flying bare to under storm
sails laying up N. by W. wind out to the W. at
five P.M. wore ship to the S by W. middle and latter
wind out W. by W. ship laying up S. E. by S the gale
continues unabated and nothing in sight

Mon May 19th

Came with a heavy gale from the W. by W. and a heavy
sea running and ship laboring much and laying up S. E.
by S. under the storm sails, ship making about
about 400 strokes in twenty four hours, before the gale came
on the ship leaked about 100 strokes in 24 hours middle
part gale abated at made easy sail and commencing boiling
latter part wind of moderate from the S.W. with a heavy
swell setting from the S.W. nothing in sight

Came with moderate breeze and a heavy swell setting
from the S.W. ship steering by the wind to the S.E.
by S. employed in boiling at four P.M. finished boiling
middle part the same latter part wind out W. at
daylight made sail and cleared S.E. with
strong breezes employed in ship's duty

Came with strong breeze from the W. course N.W.
at sunset shortened spit and directed the ship to
laying up S. by W. middle part the same at
three P.M. wore to S.W. latter part blowing
a gale from the W. at daylight wore to the S.W.
