com standing boats crew watches
middle wind light from the N.W.
ship laying up then latter part
wind moderate from the S.E. & E.
ship laid laying up S.E. & E.
employed in mending sails

Sat June 28th entirely

Came wind from the N.E. and moderate
steering by the wind to the N.W. at sunset
took in light sails and main sail, wind out
S.E. & E. ship laying up with middle part
the same at daylight made sail
at seven A.M. saw braches to windward
worked to windward in short tacks
but saw no more at noon ship laying up
S.E. saw a finback

Came with moderate breezes
from the S.E. & E. steering by the wind
to the S.E. at four P.M. tacked to the S.W.
at four P.M. saw jammers middle part
the same at four A.M. tacked to the
