Com. with moderate breeze from the E. by E. and stem weather steering by the wind to the South at sunset shortened sail to double reef and courses, saw a jumper middle part wind hauled to the N.E. at daylight made sail, and then shortly after double reefed again at seven A.M. steered S.E. latter part strong breeze employed in mending sail.

Com. with strong double reefed topsail breeze from the N.E. course S.E. at sunset shortened sail furled main sail and jib at sunset tacked to ship laying up East wind out N.W. by E. middle part wind hauled to the N.W. at daylight made sail and steered S.E. latter part thick and hazy weather from the N. and haling to the South at seven steered South and South by E. under easy sail.

Com. with strong breeze and thick hazy weather from the West steering to the South at sunset wind out South ship laying up E. by E. shortened sail to fore sail and double reefed main topsail middle and latter part moderate variable wind at daylight made easy sail and steered S.W. by W. at noon wind out S.E. with rain and thick hazy weather.
