Mon. July 28th

Came with moderate wind and variably
chiefly from the S.W. & course S.W. by W. with
squalls of rain and thick hazy weather
at sunset shortened sail to double reefed
main topsail and fore sail with the wind
out East middle and latter part calms
and light variable catpaws saw grampuses

Tues July 29th

Came with calms and light variable catpaws
ship working to the West slowly at sunset
took in light sail middle part the same
at daylight a light breeze from the
W. & N.W. ship laying up S. by E. and S.W.
at eleven saw a finback at noon ship
laying up S. by E.

Wed July 30th

Came with light winds and fine clear weather
from the West steering by the wind to the S. by E. at
two P.M. tacked to the S.W. at four P.M.
tacked to the S.W. the wind out W. & N.W.
at sunset shortened sail to double reefed top
sails jib and foresail middle part moderate
winds ship laying up S. latter part strong
breezes double reefed the topsails, employed
in ships duty

Thurs July 31st

Came with strong breezes from the W. & N.W. steering
by the wind to the S. at five P.M. wore to the S.W.
at sunset shortened sail to double reefed top
and fore sail middle part moderate
at five A.M. wind hauled to the S.W. by W.
ship laying up N.W. by W. land light
wind at daylight made all sail snuff
finbacks latter part ship laying up N.W.

Came with light winds fine weather from the S.W. by
S. steering by the wind with all drawing sail
set to the W. by E. at nine P.M. wind died
away to a calm middle part the same at
five A.M. a light breeze sprang up from the
North latter part wind moderate from
the same quarter.

Lat Aug 2nd

Came with moderate breezes and fine weather
from the S.W. at sunset shortened sail to
double reefed topsails at six P.M. the wind out
S.W. ship laying up N. by E. at nine P.M.
wind hauled to the N. by E. ship heading South
at daylight made sail at seven A.M. wore to the
N.W. latter part strong breezes saw
plenty finbacks

Sund August 3rd

Came with strong breezes from the W. & N.W. steering
by the wind to the S.W. at three P.M.
ship heading N. by E. at four P.M. double
reefed, plenty finbacks in sight breaching
and spouting middle part wind out S. by E.
at eight P.M. wore to the S. at three
A.M. wore to the Westward at daylight made sail

Mon Aug 4th

Came with moderate breezes from the S.W. by
and S.W. steering by the wind to the Westward
at sunset ship laying up N. by E. middle
part light variable wind and calms
at five A.M. wind out S.W. ship laying
up N. by E. nothing in sight
