Came with moderate wind, from the N.W. steering by the wind to the W.S.W. at sunset, took in light sail, middle and latter part thick dark, and heavy weather with the wind cut to the W. ship laying up. D.I.W. latter part, as the weather looked bad shortened sail to close reefed main topsail and storm sail came D.I.W.

Wed Aug 6th

Came with strong and thick dark and threatening weather, steering under close reefed main topsail and storm sail, came D.I.W. and to the W. at three P.M. set foresail and double reefed fore topsail, as the weather looked better, at sunset ship laying up. D.I.W. by D. middle and latter part blowing a light gale from the W. lying hove to under close reefed m. topsail and fore sail.

Thurs Aug 7th

Came with a light gale from the W. lying hove to under close reefed m. topsail and foresail ship laying up. D.I.W. middle and latter part, much the same, standing along to the S under easy sail.

Frid Aug 8th

Came with strong breezes and a heavy swell from the W.S.W. ship laying up South under easy sail at sunset shortened sail close reef m. topsail fore sail middle and latter part much the same at day light shortened fore topsail double reefed at four A.M. wore ship to the N.W. employed in unreefing sail.

Came with moderate breezes and a heavy swell from the W. and squally steering by the wind to the N.W. under double reefed topsail and carrying at sunset furled main sail middle and latter part, much the same at seven P.M. was to the South.

Sund Aug 10th

Came with moderate breezes from W.S.W. steering by the wind to South at sunset shortened sail middle part the same, latter part, wind hauled to the N.W. ship laying up W. by South at day light made all sail at noon the breezes freshening took in light sail the weather dark and squally.

Mon Aug 11th

Came with strong breezes and dark squally weather from the N.W. steering by the wind to the West at three P.M. the wind increasing double reefed and furled m. sail at sunset ship heading W.S.W. middle part wind cut W.S.W. ship laying up N.W. at daylight made easy sail at eleven A.M. the ship laying up South wore around to the N.W.

Came with moderate breezes and fair weather from the W.S.W. steering by the wind to the N.W. at sunset ship laying up N.W. by W. middle part the same, latter part ship laying up W. by N. and fine light wind and clear weather plenty pinbacks in sight.
