Came with light winds from the North ship laying up N by E. at sunset wind out N by E ship laying up S W took in light sails middle and latter part wind out N.W. at daylight made sail plenty finbacks in sight

Thurs Aug 21st

Came with light winds from the N.W. steering by the wind to the W.S.W. at sunset took in light sails middle part the same at five A.M. wind hauled in a squall to the S.W. and continued until nine A.M. when it came in steady from S.W. to W. ship heading to the Southward with light rain squally

Frid Aug 22nd

Came with light winds from the S.W. ship laying up S.E. and South at four P.M. heaved to the N.E. at sunset took in light sails and double reefed the topsails at ten P.M. were to the S.E. middle part the same at four A.M. were N.E. at daylight made sail saw finbacks employed in mending sails

Sat Aug 23rd

Came with moderate winds from the S.W. steering by the wind to the N.E. at sunset shortened sail to double reefed main topsail and foresail as it was squally at midnight the wind out South bore up and steered N by E. at daylight made sail and steered N.E. at noon steered West saw finbacks

Sunday Aug 24th

Came with moderate winds from the North course West nothing in sight at sunset the wind out S.E. took in light sails and mainsail middle part wind out East at midnight luffed to the wind at daylight made sail and steered West saw humpbacks latter part and passed over Hapels Bank latter part strong breezes at eleven A.M. in blue water at noon stood S.W.

Mon Aug 25th

Came with strong breezes from the East course South West at sunset shortened sail to double reefed main topsail and foresail at sunset thick misty weather and squally luffed to the wind laying up S.E. middle part the same at daylight made easy sail and steered N.W. at eleven A.M. steered S.W. latter part strong breezes and clear weather at ten A.M. saw blackfish lowered for them without success

Came with strong breezes from the East course S.W. at sunset luffed to laying up S.E. and shortened sail to double reefed main topsail and foresail and storm sail at midnight went to the North at daylight made sail and steered to the N.E. at noon luffed to the wind laying up N.E. nothing in sight employed in ship's duty
