Com with a moderate breeze and clear weather from the W. & N. by E. by E. with a heavy swell from the S. W. by W. in sight at sunset shortened sail and hove to laying up North, middle part wind died away to a calm at five A.M. light breeze from the E. ship laying up S. by E. at nine A.M. wind out S. by E. were to the E. N. E. at noon blowing strong double reefed the topsails, show pinbacks

Com with breezes and a heavy swell from the S. E. and squally ship laying up E. N. E. at four P.M. the wind increased to a light gale shortened sail to close reefed in topsail and storm sail, at sunset the weather looking dark and threatening middle part the same latter part gale abated a little but the weather thick and hazy no obs

Wedth Sept 10th

Com with a strong breeze and heavy swell, with the weather squally and hazy from the S. E. ship laying up E. N. E. at one P.M. easy sail at three P.M. wind very light at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part the same at noon wind died away with fog set in no obs

Com with a calm and thick hazy weather at five P.M. a light breeze sprung up from the S. W. ship laying up S. by E. at sunset foggy shortened sail to foresail and double reefed main topsail at ten P.M. blowing a gale from the S. by E. ship laying up S. by E. furlled foresail and close reefed the main topsail middle and latter part the same

Fridth Sept^r 12th

Com with a moderate gale from the S. by E. ship hove to under close reefed main topsail and storm sail, laying up S. by E. by South and S. E. middle part the same at daylight set foresail and first topsail close reefed and steered East at noon steered E. N. E. the weather the same

Satth Sept^r 13th

Com with a moderate gale from the S. W. running under close reefed fore and main topsail and foresail steering E. N. E. at four P.M. heaved to the wind furlled foresail and fore topsail ship laying up S. by E. middle part the same latter part the gale broke at daylight set fore sail and steered N. E. and at S. by E. at noon steered N. E. by E.
