Sun Nov 16th

Came with a moderate gale with heavy squalls
from the S.W. running under double reefed main
mainsail and foresail to the E.S.E. at two
P.M. failed the foresail and steered East at five
P.M. steered E by N. and close reefed main topsail
middle part the wind moderate at six A.M.
set foresail and double reefed topsail and
steered N.E. at noon steered N.E.

Mon Nov 17th

Came with moderate breeze and heavy swell
from the S.W. course N.E. at sunset
shortened sail and luffed to the wind
laying up S.E. middle and latter part
strong breeze with squalls at day
light made easy sail and stood to the
S.E. saw finback at noon steered N.E.

Tues Nov 18th

Came with strong breeze with squalls
from the S.W. course N.E. saw finback
at sunset shortened sail and steered East
middle and latter part much the same
at five A.M. luffed to the wind laying
up S.E. and made sail nothing in sight
employed in ship duty

Came with moderate winds from the S.W. S.E.
and fine weather steering by the wind to the S.E.
nothing in sight at sunset shortened sail
middle and latter part wind light from
the South at daylight made sail and steered
N.E. nothing in sight at noon steered
N.E.

Thurs Nov 20th

Came with light winds and fine clear
weather from the South course N.E. at
five P.M. saw blackfish hauled
and struck three and saved two of them
at sunset shortened sail heading to the
Eastward middle part the same latter
part light winds and calms employed
in hauling blackfish

Frid Nov 21st

Came with a calm light in boiling
blackfish sunset shortened sail
middle and latter part light
wind from the W. S.W. at daylight
made sail and steered by the
wind to the South at noon
made out the steered N.E.
nothing in sight
