Saturday Dec. 29th

Came with calm and fine weather nothing in sight at sunset shortened sail middle part the same at five A.M. wind light from the North at daylight made sail and steered S.W. nothing in sight

Sun. Nov. 30th

Came with light winds from the N and fine weather steering S.W. nothing in sight at sunset shortened sail and luffed to laying up W.N.W. middle part latter part the same at daylight made sail and steered S.W. during the forenoon lowered and caught a small fish at noon steered South

Monday Dec. 1st 1850

Came with light winds and fine weather from the North course South nothing in sight at sunset shortened sail and steered West middle part wind hauled in to the S.E. at daylight hauled on the wind laying up S.W. and made sail saw finbacky at ten A.M. steered South

Lat by Obs. 32.17 South

Long by Chron. 174.14 East

Tues. Dec. 2nd

Came with moderate breezes and fine beautiful weather from the N.E. course South nothing in sight at sunset shortened sail and steered West at nine P.M. bore to the S.E. at daylight made sail and steered S.W. saw finbacky employed in painting boat at noon altered the course to S.E.

Wed. Dec. 3rd

Came with moderate breezes from the N.E. course S.E. nothing in sight at sunset shortened sail and wore to the S.W. middle part blowing strong latter part blowing an light gale with thick weather at five A.M. steered West under close reefed main topsail and storm sail at noon wore to laying up S.W. by C.
