Came with moderate winds and fine weather from the E.S.E. steering by the wind to the S.E. at one P.M. saw a bark steering to the N. also saw finbacks at sunset shortened sail middle part wind light latter part moderate breeze at daylight made sail and wore to the North saw finbacks

Came with moderate breezes from the E.S.E. and fine clear weather steering by the wind to the North at two P.M. steered N.W. finbacks in sight at sunset shortened sail and clipped to the wind lying up North as the foretop sail was being furled one of our boatsteersmen fell overboard of the yard but lodged on the fore yard where he hung until he was aided down he had received no injury middle part the same at daylight made sail steering by the wind to the N. and E.S.W.

Came with moderate breezes from the N.E. steering by the wind to the N.E.W. at sunset shortened sail and steered West with the wind out E.S.E. middle part the same at daylight made sail and steered S.W. at two P.M. hauled on the wind lying up S.E. saw a whaler boiling steering to the S.E.
