

Buque Brighton of Dartmouth
Mon Dec 22nd

Came with light wind from the N.W.
steering to the E by S. in company
with the Com. Maud at sunset
shortened sail laying in N.W.
middle part the same at daylight
made sail latter part wind light
saw some of the United States
Sloop Capt. Watson. at anchor at
Mudde's Point Cape of North Zealand
bearing South East by East bearing
Lat by 34.17

Tues Dec 23rd

Came with light wind from the
W. by S. steering to the E by S.
Saw the Com. Maud at sunset
shortened sail laying in S.W.
middle and latter part calm
at daylight bore in sight bearing
W. about twenty miles the wind
in sight working in shore at ten AM
a light breeze sprang up from the
Westward steering to the E by S.
Lat by 34.17

Wed. Dec 24th

Came with light wind and fine
weather from the Westward steering to
the N.W. under all sail nothing in sight
at sunset shortened sail according to
the Com. Maud in crossing oil
middle part calm and light wind
at daylight made sail latter
part calm employed in stowing
down oil

Lat by 34.18

Came with light wind from the West
steering to the E by S. at sunset
shortened sail middle part light wind
and variable latter part wind light
from the East at daylight made
sail steering by the wind to the Northward
saw porpoises saw a flock of sheep
floating by the ship

Thurs Dec 25th

Came with light wind and fine weather
from the Eastward steering by the wind
to the N.E. at sunset shortened sail
middle part wind moderate from the E
latter part strong breeze at daylight
sail and stood along by the wind to the
N.E. nothing in sight
