Sat Jan 3rd

Came with wind very light from the South
steering by the wind to the N.E.W. at four
P.M. wind died away to a calm at
sunset shortened sail middle part
the same latter part wind light
from the N.E.W. at daylight
made sail and steered South
nothing in sight

Sund Jan 4th

Came with light wind and fine
weather from the N.E.W. course
South at sunset let took in
light sail middle and latter
part wind light from the N
steering to the Southward at daylight
made the three Kings leaving S.E.
did five leagues but noon spoke
Bark gone off Fair Haven

Mon Jan 5th

Came with light wind from the N
steering to the Southward in company
of the Bark at sunset shortened sail
lying up N. middle part rain
and squally wind hauled to the S.W.
ship lying up to the S.E. latter
part clear with strong breezes at
noon at 11 wore to the N.E.W.
saw finback

Capt Abner Tucker Mast
Tues Jan 6th

Came with strong breezes from the S.W.
steering by the wind lying up N.E.W.
at sunset shortened sail saw finback
middle and latter part wind out S.W.
at daylight made sail lying up N.E.
w bore several sails steering to the East

Wed Jan 7th

Came with moderate breezes and a heavy
swell from the S.W. steering by the wind
to the W at sunset shortened sail and
wore to the Eastward middle part wind
hauled in to the S.E. ship lying up E.S.E.
at daylight made sail at eight A.M.
wore to the S.W. nothing in sight

Thurs Jan 8th

Came with moderate wind from the
S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W.
at two P.M. stered N.E.W. nothing
in sight at sunset shortened sail
and huffed to lying up S.W.
middle and latter part the same
at daylight made sail
