Came with a light gale and hazy weather from the East ship lying up S. S. E. employed in fitting rigging and new topsails. At sunset shortened fly jibb from middle part more moderate and with thick weather latter part were to the N. N. E. employed in sending up fore topsail

Frid Jan 16th

Came with strong breezes with thick weather from the East ship lying up N. N. E. employed in setting up rigging sending up fore topsail yard and fore topsail at six PM set double reefed topsail middle and latter parts. Light breeze with foggy at daylight made sail employed in fitting rigging

Sat Jan 17th

Came with light breezes and foggy from the East in steering by the wind to the N. N. E. employed in fitting the rigging at sunset shortened sail middle and latter parts the same

Sun Jan 18th

Came with light wind and foggy from the E. S. E. ship lying up North at one PM the haze lifted up a little wind hauled to the N. E. made sail at sunset shortened sail middle and latter parts calm light wind and hazy saw blackbirds loosed and chased without success at noon flat calm



Mon Jan 19th

Came with a calm and hazy at one PM took the wind light from the N. E. steering by the wind to the S. E. at sunset took in light sails middle and latter parts little or no wind and thick and foggy at noon the fog lifted with the wind light from the S. E. steering by the wet wind to the S. S. W.

Came with wind light and light passing haze from the S. E. steering by the wind to the S. S. W. at sunset shortened sail that is took in light sails middle and latter parts strong breezes from the E by S at daylight ship lying up S. S. E. saw a brig standing to the North employed in ships duty
