Tues Jan 27th

Com. with moderate wind and fine weather from the East employed in cutting at two P.M. finished cutting and com. clearing up deck at seven P.M. shortened sail set the watch sleep laying up. At the middle part the same at daylight made sail and steered N.W. employed in hoisting saw a brig standing to the South

Wednes 28th

Com. with moderate wind, and fine weather from the E. course N.W. nothing in sight employed in boiling at sunset shortened sail and steered West at ten P.M. finished boiling middle part wind the same at daylight made sail and steered S.W. saw black fish

Began with moderate wind and fine weather from the East course S.W. at four P.M. steered S.E. & W. at sunset shortened middle part strong breeze latter part saw porpoises employed in setting another pot in the tryworks as one of them was cracked at noon steered to the N.W.

Com. with moderate wind and fine clear weather from the East course N.W. at ten P.M. steered N.W. at sunset shortened sail and steered N.W. & E. at eight P.M. steered N.W. by N. at daylight made sail saw pinbacks latter part wind out to the S.E. course to the N.W.

Sunday Feb 1st 1857

Com. with moderate wind and fine weather from the S.E. steering to the N.W. nothing in sight at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part much the same at daylight made sail saw a ship and a brig at eight A.M. made Fort Hove's Island bearing N.W. distant 45 miles

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
