West ditto from leagues course N.W. through the night steering to the N.W. by N. latter part strong breeze at daylight made sail the land bearing S.E. dist twelve leagues at eight A.M. steered N.W. at noon A.M. steered S.W.

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Tues Feb 3rd

Came fresh breeze from the S.E. course S.W. at three P.M. luffed to the wind laying up S.W. at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part wind strong from the East at daylight made sail laying up to the Southward employed in cooping and bent a forecast covered fore top gallant yard nothing in sight

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Wed Feb 4th

Came with strong breeze and clear weather from the Eastward steering by the wind to the Southward employed in cooping at 5 P.M. passed a merchant brig bound to the S.W. at sunset shortened sail middle part squally and raining latter part fine weather spoke the State of Sydney Capt. Targent at noon the wind hauled laying up S.E.

Thurs Feb 5th

Came with moderate wind and fine weather from the S.E. steering by the wind under all sail to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail took in light sail ship laying up S.E. middle and latter part wind hauling latter part wind at N.W. steering to the Eastward employed in stowing down oil stowed down 54 Bbls nothing in sight
