

Remarks in Board the Barque Brighton 1837

Thursday 26th March
This day comes in with a Gale and Raining
Nothing doing only one Boat goes on deck
at a blize Wind a little abated this
evening but a heavy sea ceased Raining
at four P.M. I should like to see what
Weather once more and Whales we are
hoping to get a couple of hundred
Belongs the End of April Middle and lat
part Moderate a little but thick fog and
Mist Wind from S.W. being sea & Ship still
continuous to look the same as usual.

Friday 27th March

This day comes in foggy and Raining a
little not much Wind sprang up fresh
Boat out half past three P.M. under
double reefed Topsails and Grouse bands
variously employed Carpenter and Cooper
putting spade 1 pole the Boat cleared of
duty Boat took on all sail at Sunset
Weather looks like rain and Wind
Ship heading S.W. all day but fog & thick
fog & rain on sail in sight from Mast head
last continues to look at by the
long by Chron

Saturday 28th March

This day commences with a strong Breeze from
the Southward and heavy sea hauled variously
employed. Carpenter employed putting down
the Masting Machine Weather
still dark and stormy double reefed Topsail
Boat all day took in sail at the usual time
called all hands and made sail at day light
Went for Whales at half past eight A.M. but did
not see them again after searching
lost them in the fog I found they must have been
the ship as we were close to them before we saw them
had seen them and happy with the ship two Brothers
lat by obs 31. 28

Sunday 29th March
This day comes in with a fine Breeze from S.W.
been looking all the afternoon for the Whales that
escaped us this morning in the fog but no success
without success weather Moderate this
evening quite pleasant took in sail
at Sun Set. two sail in sight Middle
and lat part light Wind made sail at day
light had a little Rain and Mist
cleared up near Noon

Monday 30th March

This day comes in with a light Wind
from the Eastward steering by the Wind
heading S.E. by S. took in sail at Sun Set
Weather looks like more Rain again this
evening Middle part Raining lat part fine
day and light Wind Nothing doing but
looking out for Whales and ship duty
had all sail out all day two sail in
sight

Tuesday 31st March

This day commences with a light Breeze
from S.W. steering by the Wind heading S.E.
looks dark and stormy again this evening
took in sail at the usual time
Middle and lat part Raining and foggy
Light Wind from S.W. steering by the Wind
and Westward till noon then more ship and
Wind to the Southward and Eastward

lat by obs 31. 28
