

Remarks on Board Bark *Albrighton* 1857

Monday 11th May S
This day commences with a strong wind from N.W. with heavy swell at three P.M. had heavy squalls and the sails the 2^d best Breeze and split the sail from one end to the other set it in and repaired it at four wind hauled round to S.W. more ship to the Northward and Westward wind blowing and squally ship heaving considerably Middle part strong third from S.W. Steering by the wind N.W. Last part moderated set all sail Steering N.W. two points free Lat by obs 31. 13 South Ship still continues to work Long. Chron 170 East

Tuesday 12th May
This day commences with fine weather and Moderate Breeze from S.W. Steering course N.W. all sail set hands employed Making Spun yarn and various other little jobs Middle part heavy light Breeze and Blowing from S.W. to Lat part the same fine weather Weather much the same

Lat by obs 31. 33 South

Wednesday 13th May
This day commences with very light Breeze from N.W. Steering course N.W. employed painting the Charnels and Making spun yarn at half past three P.M. sprang up a fine Breeze from S.W. at six took in the fore topgallant sail Weather getting dark and blowing Middle part strong topgallant Breeze at ten set the fore topgallant sail Lat part the same saw a fine Breeze at eleven on the lake moderately approaching Lat by obs 32. 13 South

Thursday 14th May 1857
This day commences with a strong topgallant Breeze from the Eastward Steering course S.W. by N half N. employed clearing the fore mast on the middle and taking it apart to oil ship. Calm badly in heavy sea and when it rains I do not think there is a dry Berth in the ship even to the Capt's Room looks the deck want cutting badly Middle part strong Breeze Lat part light Breeze and squally from the Eastward Lat by obs 32. 37.8
Long. Chron 163.00 East

Friday 15th May
This day commences with light Breeze and squalls of Rain from S.W. to East Steering N.W. employed churning and painting the middle saw a school of porpoises but could not shoot any started two or three times and broke up Middle part light Breeze from East to South Lat part nearly calm very light air from the Eastward no alteration perceivable in the lake this day Lat by obs 32. 57 South
Long. Chron

Saturday 16th May
This day commences with light air from the Eastward employed churning out for A. Pipe of Wood and Painting the Charnels we have two more Pipes independent of the one we opened at five P.M. Breeze up a little from S.W. Steering S.W. by N. employed Middle part nearly calm Lat part the same employed churning out for water Meat and Potatoes no alteration perceivable in the lake today Lat by obs
