5 Saturday the 5 fine weather with the from N E during
S W saw blackfish at sunset took in the top galant
sails and steered W S W at daylight made sale saw blackfish
to work backing out the main hole for water saw blackfish and
sails so ends lat 14 11 long 22 15 W

6 Sunday the 6 fine weather with like air from N E
steering W S W at sundown took in the fore top galant
sails at daylight set it again saw two sales of the starboard
sails and a school of blackfish so ends

7 Monday the 7 cloudy weather with like air from N E
steering S W saw blackfish at sunset took in the top galant
sails steered S W all night at daylight made all sale there
being sale of the starboard beam and at 11 I saw a mother
of the same kind so ends 13 07 N long 22 30 W

8 Tuesday the 8 thick cloudy and especially with rain with
moderate breeze from N E steering S by W there being two sales
in site at sunset took in the little sails jib and spanker and
double sailed the top sails fished the main sail at daylight made
sale steered S by W saw jumpers last part fine weather with
like air from N E steering S by W 12 33 N 23 35 W

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Wednesday the 9 fine weather with a smoky horizon with like
air from N E steering S by W the wind saw fishbacks at sunset
at high in the little sails jib and spanker came all the rest of
the day at daylight made sale saw fishbacks and grampasses
so ends lat 11 31 N 23 37 W

Thursday the 10 begins calm and cloudy at 4 P.M. began squally
three sales in site at sundown took in the little sails at 9 00
I saw the main top galant sails the evening all the way from
E to west W steering S by E at daylight made all sale the weather
squally and many three subsistence winds 10 50 N 23 17 W

Friday the 11 cloudy weather and squally the wind veering from
E to N W steering S by E at sunset took in the fore top galant
sails and top galant and steered S S E squally and rainy there
at night at daylight made sale the wind from E by N
steering a moderate breeze steering S S E six sales in site saw
grampasses so ends

Saturday the 12 fine weather with a like breeze from S S W
and smoky horizon bearing W by S six sales in site came
along rain weather there the night at daylight had a strong
breeze from the southward and westward heading to the southward
and eastward 4 sales in site so ends

Sunday the 13 rainy squally weather with a strong
breeze from S S W heading S E two sales in sight at 7
P.M. sat sea watches for the night and made all sale
at 7 P.M. called the landward watch there being
four sales in sight saw blackfish and struck and drew
a grampasse so ends W H 53
