23 Wednesday the 23 fine weather with lite ares from S^W heading S S E by the wind at 5.00 P.M. saw sprouts off the weather bow and did not know what they were fine weather all night with lite breezes at 11.00 A.M. saw a humpback 11.00

24 Thursday the 24 fine weather with moderate breezes from S^W heading S S E by the wind saw fyrbucks lite wind all night at 8.00 A.M. saw two shoals of blackfish and sprouts ahead but did not get near enough to tell what hea was so ends

25 Friday the 25 weather fine with lite winds from S S^W heading S E by the wind at half past 5.00 A.M. lashed heading S^W S^W saw fyrbucks to work on the rigging so ends

26 Saturday the 26 fine weather with moderate breezes from S heading W S W by the wind moderate all night at 10.00 A.M. saw fyrbucks so ends but did not know

27 Sunday the 27 fine weather with moderate breezes from S heading W S W by the wind moderate breezes all night last part fine saw nothing so ends

28 Monday the 28 fine weather with moderate breezes from S S E heading S^W by S by the wind to work brabring out the main hole for bread mitch and last part smoky so ends

29 Tuesday the 29 smoky weather with strong breezes from S S E heading S^W by S by the wind mitch and last part strong breezes varying all sale so ends

30 Wednesday the 30 cloudy weather with strong breezes from S S E heading S^W by S varying all sale strong breezes and squally all night at 5.00 A.M. took in the fore topgalantale and gafftopsail saw braches some lat 6.35 lon 15.03

31 Thursday the 31 cloudy squally weather with strong breezes from S S E varying all sale except the fore topgalantale and gafftopsail heading S^W saw sprouts and sails at 8.00 P.M. out the fore topgalantale and gafftopsail at 9.00 P.M. took them in again at 9.00 A.M. took in the main topgalantale at 7.00 A.M. single reefed the topsails and took in the job at 11.00 A.M. shook the reef out of the main topsails and set the job so ends

September the first Friday squally weather with strong breezes from S S E heading S^W by the wind saw humpbacks at 5.00 P.M. Dible reefed the topsails took in job and spanker squally all night at 9.00 A.M. shook the reef out set the job and spanker saw humpbacks so ends
