

Barb Bruce bound E of Madagascar

Wednesday November 22 begins fine with light breezes E by S heading S E by the wind at 4 P.M. the wind haled to N steered S all the rest of the day moderate and calm so ends lat 28.53 S long 43-6 E

Thursday November 23 begins cloudy with moderate breezes from S W steering E by S under all sail middle part strong breezes from S steering by the wind at half past 12 took in the fore top galant sail and gaff top sail at 3 P.M. took in the top galant sail and double reefed the top sail at 5 took one reef out of the main top sail last part strong breezes from S E so ends

Friday November 24 begins with strong breezes from S E steering ~~by the~~ wind heading E N under double reefed top sails courses. jib spanker at 2 P.M. tacked heading S by W at 2 P.M. made all sail at 5 P.M. took the top galant sail and gaff top sail and tacked ship heading E saw two sails so ends

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Saturday November 25 begins with strong breezes from S S E heading E by the wind one of the above mentioned sails in sight saw several humpbacks at 9 P.M. wore ship heading S S W by the wind halled up the main sail blowing strong at 5 P.M. tacked heading E N E so jumps and a calm so ends

Sunday November 26 begins cloudy with strong breezes from S E heading E N E by the wind at 4 P.M. tacked heading S S W and single reefed the main top sail double reefed the fore headed. So last part headed S by E saw bynductis so ends

Monday November 27 begins foggy with strong breezes from E heading S S E at 8 P.M. set the main top galant sail and gaff top sail middle part specially at 1 P.M. took them in at half past 2 P.M. double reefed the fore top sail and single reefed the blowing strong from N E heading E S E at five double reefed the main top sail last part strong gales from N E so ends
