Wednesday November 29 begins cloudy with strong gales from S W steering E N E saw a sail steering to the N and W broke out meat at 4 P.M. hoisted up the mast boat and took the things out of the harbor boat strong gales from S E last part strong breezes from S sat spunkies and gaff topsails and steered from ahead pass so ends

Thursday November 30 begins cloudy with strong breezes from S steering E N E at 4 P.M. steered N N E moderate breezes all night last part fine weather with the breezes to work fitting main topsails and rigging

December Day one the first begins fine with the breezes from N E steering N at 4 P.M. steered N W at sun set took in the little sails gib and spunkies and sat boats saw a sail at 9 P.M. hoisted up the main sail at 8 M hoisted up the foresail at day light sat the courses gib and spunkies and main topsails

December Saturday 2 begins fine with moderate breezes from N steering W N W saw a sail at sunset took in the little sails gib and spunkies and hoisted up the main sail steered by the wind last part calm at daylight made sail sat gib spunkies and main sails so ends

Sunday December 3 begins calm at 2 P.M. had a little breeze from S steered N W W saw a sail at sunset took in the little sails gib spunkies and hoisted the topsails and filled the main sail and hoisted to the wind heading W N W at day light made sail shook the reefs sat the main topsails gib spunkies and main sail at 7 P.M. hoisted down the gib and spunkies and steered N W by N so ends
