February Thursday 22 commences fine wind from N.E. started W by N at 2 P.M. so white water started for it heading S at 5 P.M. speedily wore shape heading S.W. by S. made part fine steering W.N.W. the wind from the Eastward at daylight made all sail so fine weather so ends lat 2-30 S long 54-22 E

Friday February 23 commences fine with light airs from the Eastward steering to the N and W so several species of whale at sunset took in the light sails and fished the main sail. started W.N.W. made part fine with the wind from N.W. heading W at daylight made all sail the weather fine so fine weather so ends lat 2-45 S

Saturday 24 commences fine with light breezes from N heading W by N by the wind at 4 P.M. took on board at sunset took in the light sails and main sail made part started by the wind heading N.W. at daylight made all sail heading W by N a fine weather so ends lat 2-43 S long 54-26 E

Sunday 25 commences fine with light airs from N.W. heading W at sunset took in the light sails at 10 P.M. sat the main sail at sunset the wind from N.E. steering N.W. at daylight made all sail started W by N moderate breezes and fine weather so ends lat 2-33 S long 52-02 E

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Monday 26 commences fine with light breezes from N steering W by N at sunset took in the foretop sail at daylight made all sail so fine weather so ends lat 2-35 S long 51-10 E

Tuesday 27 commences fine with moderate breezes from N.E. at 7 P.M. so large breeze to windward started heading E S.E. at sunset started S.W. at 8 P.M. started W by N at half past 8 took in the fore top sail at daylight sat it again started the same fine weather so ends lat 2-30 S long 49-02 E

Wednesday 28 commences fine with moderate breezes from N.E. steering W by N at sunset started W by N half N at 11 P.M. the squalls of the fore top sail at daylight sat the fore top sail so grand weather black fish and killed so ends with fine weather lat 2-30 S long 48-11 E

March Thursday the first fine weather with light breezes from N.E. steering W by N at 3 P.M. so started back to the Eastward at 5 P.M. started the same breeze out the main sail at 6 P.M. and fresh moderate breeze at 9 P.M. took in the fore top sail started up fore sail and main sail of fore and fished to with the main yard aback at daylight made all sail started W the wind from N.E. fine weather so ends lat 2-42 S long 46-18 E
