Monday 1st commences with fine weather with moderate breezes N steering W at 4 took a rain squall at sundown took in the light sails fore and spanker main sail at 11 P.M. double reefed the topsails hauled up the fore sail luffed to the wind on the larboard tack at daylight made sail at 9 A.M. took in the fore topsail and fore 20 reefed foretopsail so ends lat 64° 23' S long 45° 55' E

Tuesday 2nd commences fine with moderate breezes from N.E. steering S.S.W. at sunset took in the light sails double reefed the topsails put in middle part cloudy with variable winds steering S by W at daylight made sail steered by the wind heading S.W. by S at 8 the wind haled to E steering S by W at 9 so aback were kept stood for it so named of it were round to her same course so ends lat 65° 15' S long 45° 48' E

Wednesday 3rd commences with light airs from E steering S by W so reefed at sundown took in the light sails at 9 P.M. set the main topsail and fore sail and last part fine so gumpress and fairsails steering S by W wind N.E. so ends lat 67° 00' S long 45° 40' E

Thursday 4th commences cloudy with light breezes from the Eastward steering S by W at fairsails at sunset took in the light sails double reefed the topsails put in the mainsails steered S.S.W. middle and last part squally rainy at 9 P.M. luffed to the wind on the larboard tack fore and

hauled up at 10 more ship heading N.W. at daylight made sail steered S by W at 11 A.M. took in the main topsail and 20 gumpress and fairsails so ends lat 68° 00' S long 45° 35' E

Friday 5th commences squally and rainy with variable winds at 3 P.M. hauled up the fore sail haled down fore and double reefed the topsails steering S.S.W. at sunset luffed to the wind heading N.W. by S haled back the main yard set the mainsail and last part fine made sail so fairsails gumpress steered S by W by sunset lat 69° 55' S long 45° 38' E

Saturday 6th commences fine with light airs from N.E. steered S by W middle part calm and light air from N.E. steering S.S.E. at daylight made all sail last part calm so gumpress so ends lat 68° 09' S long 45° 55' E

Sunday 7th commences fine and calm so fairsails at sunset hauled up the main sail in the light sails and down fore and spanker at 11 P.M. made all sail light airs from S heading N.W. by W last part fine so double reefed fairsails so ends lat 68° 24' S long 45° 25' E

Monday 8th commences fine with light airs from S heading N.W. by W so fairsails made and latter part fine so suffer bottoms fairsails so ends with fine weather S.S.W. lat 69° 50' S long 45° 05' E
