

March 1849

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Since leave towards the comers Grand March 1849

Saturday 10 commences fire with light 4.8 from
S.E. heading S.W. under all side etc work on the
singing with post fire leaving S.E. the wind from
E at 7 A.M. so black fish at 8 loaded the boats the fish
boat much up. Hauled last ^{part} spawls of same heading S.W. at
lat 10.33 S long 44.28 E

Sunday 11 commences with cloudy weather and light was from
S.E. at 10.30 in middle part light was S.W. at
at 1.30 school ship heading S.E. at 4.10 etc in
the island of grain Pomare in sight dist 38 miles
so grasspastes so ends lat 10.42 S long 43.51 E

Monday 12 commences fire and carm at 4.10
light was from S.W. heading to S and E and
so blackfish grasspastes the above mentioned island
in sight bearing S.W. dist 30 miles northward
but part so uncertain. Blackfish and grasspastes
lat 10.02 S long 43.20 E

Tuesday 13 commences fire and carm so grasspastes and
blackfish with part light was heading S. but part fire with
light was from S.W. heading to Eastward the above mentioned
island in sight and a school so grasspastes blackfish lat 10.30 S
long 42.32 E

29 bearing S.E.

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Wednesday 14 commences fire with light was from
S.W. heading Eastward so grasspastes with part light
was from various ways heading to the Eastward later part
was so ends lat 10.30 S long 42.06 E

Thursday 15 commences fire with carm so blackfish
with part spawls with light was from S.W. const-
stantly heading E by N. at part fire heading E by N
so grasspastes blackfish so ends lat 10.21 S
long 42.22 E

Friday 16 commences with light was from the
island heading E by N. much part carm at 1.10
at 1.40 school ship came up the light was from
the top of the hill up mountain spawls and fish later
part carm so ends lat 10.05 S long 42.20 E

Saturday 17 commences fire and carm so grasspastes and
blackfish with part light was from various ways
heading to the S and E last part carm so grasspastes
lat 10.00 S long 42.11 E

Sunday 18 commences carm so grasspastes and grasspastes
with part light was from the Eastward heading S.W.
at daylight the wind shifted to the Northward heading
S.W. so grasspastes druck and rowed from here
lat 10.45 S
long 42.18 E
