Tuesday 10 commences sailing with moderate breezes from S.W. heading S.E. under all sail at 4 P.M. tacked ship heading to S and W. gained corner in sight bearing E S E dist 10 yds made port strong breezes from S heading W S W at 4 P.M. tacked ship heading E S E so ends but 10 18

Wednesday 11 commences squally with rain took
in the fore top galant sail the wind shifted to SE
breeze heading SSW 1/2 W. 1/2 W. 1/2 W. 1/2 W. 1/2 W.
Ely 1/2 at dark breeze heading S 1/2 W 1/2 W at 10 P.M.
breeze of one evening. Gage at a little further again

Takes days to run over slowly with the wind
pinning by the steering to the side at a right angle
