

Monday 23 commences with strong breezes from S S W steering to the Eastward by the wind so spouts to the leeward took in the mainsail jib and spanker made fast ^{way} specially last mast moderate breeze from S S E heading S and Westward so a fine back ends lat 05.06 S long 46.26 E

Tuesday 24 commences cloudy with moderate breeze from S heading N S W by the wind at sunset double reefed the topsails fored jib and spanker at 12 were ship to the Eastward at daylight struck out the reefs set the jib and spanker so ends

Wednesday 25 commences with fine weather and light breeze from S E heading to the Eastward at 10 at sail so fine breeze and spouts to the windward took in the light sails and reefed the topsails jib and spanker made fast last part at daylight were ship to the Eastward at half past 6. At 10 so spinnaker whaled at 12 lower at 12 fastened and drewed so ends lat 05.00 S long 47.29 E

Thursday 26 commences fine with light breeze from S E heading to the Eastward the above mentioned whales to windward at 2 P.M. took up the boats at sunset took in the light sails jib and spanker standing in the fore at 12 were ship at 4. At 11 were ship again at daylight were all sail struck out the reefs set the main topsails and spinnaker so ends lat 05.06 S long 48.37 E

Friday 27 commences cloudy with moderate breeze from S E heading to the Eastward at 5 P.M. took to the Westward took in the light sails jib and spanker made fast last part fine breeze all sail so fine back ends lat 05.10 S long 49.52 E

Saturday 28 commences with moderate breeze from S heading to the Westward so hauled back at 5 P.M. took to the Eastward took in the light sails jib and spanker took in jib and spanker at 12 were ship to the Westward at daylight made sail so ends lat 05.17 S long 46.18 E

Sunday 29 commences with fine weather and moderate breeze from S E heading to the Westward at sunset took in the light sails jib and spanker the mainsail jib and spanker at 12 were ship to Eastward at daylight made sail so fine back ends lat

Monday 30 commences rainy squally with light breeze from S E so breezes to the windward at sunset were sail at half past 7. At 10 were ship to the Westward at 2 were ship again at daylight made all sail shaver S E so ends lat 05.01 S long 46.50 E
