

3 Bruce Bound to the Nine Degree Channel 1849

Tuesday 21 commences with squally rainy weather and strong breezes. Under all sail at 5 P.M. took heavy spool of wind and rane took in the light sails double reefed the topsails & the main sail. Gilt sharing at 2 P.M. middle part of only took in the fore topsail hauled up foresail at 2 A.M. set then last part strong breezes from W. N. W. sharing by the wind heading N. Shock the reefs out set gilt main topgallant sail & aft topsails so ends lat 08.10 N. long 68.42 E

Wednesday 22 commences with heavy squally from W. N. W. sharing by the wind heading N. W. Shock up topgallant & down topsails at sunset took in the light sails gilt and sparker double reefed middle part strong gales and squally rain up the fore topsail several times last part strong gales from N. W. under double reefed topsails & sparker gilt so ends lat 08.25 N. long 68.48 E

Thursday 23 commences with heavy gales from W. N. W. under double reefed topsails gilt & a sparker at sunset took in the gilt middle part with heavy squally rain up the fore topsail and set it behind sparker and mainsail last part the same so ends

Friday 24 commences with heavy gales from W. N. W. fished the mainsail and fore topsail at sunset close reefed the main topsail and set the main sparker and took the things out of the starboard boat in the and

last part strong gales from W. N. W. laying two under close reefed main topsails fore and main sparker heading N. so ends lat 08.30 N. long 69.00 E

Saturday 25 commences with strong gales from W. N. W. laying two under close reefed main topsails fore and main sparker and fore topmast staysail. Under last strong gales at daylight set the fore sail and fore topsail double reefed Shock the reefs out of the main topsail set the main topgallant sail and mainsail and kept her off & ends lat 08.30 N. long 69.39 E

Sunday 26 commences with strong wind from W. N. W. heading E under single reefed main topsails double reefed fore main topgallant sail and courses at close reefed the topsails fished the mainsails at 3 P.M. fished the fore topsails shares. E. N. E. strong breezes at daylight Shock the reefs out of the main topsails set the main topgallant sail mainsail and fore topsails double reefed Shock and got a haul of 20 ends lat 08.55 N.



Monday 27 commences with strong breezes from W. N. W. heading E by N under single reefed main topsails main topgallant sail double reefed fore topsails and courses at sunset took all sails to close reefed main topsails kept to the wind heading to N set fore and main sparker a 8 at the foresail at 2 P.M. was at 3 A.M. made sail and kept her off E by N at 11 A.M. so the Island of Minicoy bearing E. S. E. distance 16 miles squally weather so ends lat 08.13 N.
