at 8 finished netting and chased the and convey them
away the boats made four trips first last first the
same at 4 last called the and chased away the other
two boats all have employed boating as ends lat 45° 10'

Friday & commences with light winds from Westward
having to I all have employed boiling inside
the the same employed. Boiling at day light
finished and cleared the decks washed off
so much S. 01

Saturday the 8 commenced fire with big hit brass
from the Western. Staring first on our Lark
and the other. Sunset took in 4th Masses and
shankers with the aim at daylight called all hands
we commenced staring down in a fire back in eyes

Sunday 9 commences fair with light breeze from
the Westward beating to the Westward so white
water all hands employ stowery canvas at sunset finish
Washed off the decks stowed 40 barrels middle part
light Breasts from N^o 11 heading S W by the Wind
at daylight made all sail so linback so ends lot

Monday 10 consenses with light breezes from N. S. W.
 heading S. V. by the Wind under all sail at sunset took
 the foretopgallantsail and tarped heading S. and W.
 at 2 A.M. took in main topgallantsail and got topsail at
 4 A.M. started to S. W. at daylight made all sail so finally
 the vessel employed, filling, cutting tables and flukes & sails
 at 12 taken to the N. and W. so made at 6. 08. 17
 long 77. 45. E

Tuesday. 11 comers fine with light breezes from the Westward heading Northward and Westward the employed sailing sailing tables and flukescares. so fairbaskets at sun at 10^h in the light sole double scaped the topsales at 10 P.M. shook the scaps out of the topsales were ship. to 10^h talked 8 times during the night at sunrise so a seton gunk clearing N.E. fine weather sound's lat 45.16 long 70.62 E
