

20th June sailing off Cape Comorin
Monday 8 commences fine with moderate breezes 18.49
from N steering E at 2.20. He luffed to heading S S W
middle part last part fine at 4.40 left her off S E
so ends lat 5.50 N long 77.30 E

Tuesday 9 commences fine with light winds from W
steering S E under topsails comes at sunset double reefed
the topsails and luffed to the wind to the S S W
middle and last part fine with light breezes from the
W at 4.40 left her off S E set whole topsails main
top sails and gaff topsails so ends lat 4.48 N long 78.50 E

Wednesday 10 commences with light squalls of rain and
light breezes from W steered N E under all sail at sunset
took in the light sails double reefed lower luffed to the
wind to N by W at 9 were ship to the S S W at 3.40
were ship again last part fine so fine backs set whole
topsails so ends lat 05.32 N long 78.46 E

Thursday 11 commences fine with light breezes from
W heading by the wind. At W set all sail at 4.40
left her off East at sunset took in the light sails
double reefed luffed to heading S S W middle and last
part fine at whole topsails so ends lat 05.20.17 N long

Friday 12 commences squally with rain the wind
from W steering by the wind heading S S W at
2.20 double reefed the above mentioned sulphur bottoms in
sight middle and last part the same under
double reefed topsails and so ends
lat 06.30 N long 79.19 E

1849 June Sailing Off Ceylon Roads 18.49
Saturday 13 commences with strong breezes W with
sugly weather heading S S W by the wind middle
part squally last part fine at 4.40 tacked ship to
S S W so ends under topsails and so ends
lat 05.28 N long 79.16 E

Sunday 14 commences with moderate breezes from
W heading S S W by the wind at sunset double reefed
the topsails took in 4.40 were ship to the
S S W middle and last part fine at 3.40 were
ship N W W at 4.40 made all sail so ends
lat 05.28 N long 79.16 E

Monday 15 commences fine with light breezes
from W heading S S W by the wind at sunset took in
the light sails double reefed luffed to the
wind to N by W at 9 were ship to the S S W at 3.40
were ship again last part fine so fine backs set whole
topsails so ends lat 05.32 N long 78.46 E

Tuesday 16 commences fine with light breezes from W
heading S S W under all sail at 4.40 left her off S E
at sunset took in the light sails double
reefed and luffed to heading S S W middle and last
part fine at daylight were all sail and steered
to S E so captain Island so ends

Wednesday 17 commences with fine weather
and light breezes from W steering S E for
Caint. Logale at 5.40 left off at
came to anchor in the harbor and fired the
guns there being several Merchant Vessels in
the harbor and Steamers
