Friday 19 commences fine employed painting
at sunset sent the boat ashore for the liberty
men middle part last part fine the starboard
went on liberty the watch employed painting so ends

Saturday 20 commences fine the watch employed
painting the larboard watch ashore on liberty
at sunset sent the boat ashore for the liberty
men middle part fine with light buoys last part
the same all hands employed painting and
getting off water so ends

Sunday 21 commences fine all hands employed
getting water and painting middle and last
part fine the starboard watch ashore on liberty
so ends

Monday 22 commences fine the starboard watch
ashore at sunset sent the boat ashore for
the liberty men middle part fine last part
the larboard watch went on liberty the starboard
watch employed stowing down water so ends

23 Bruce lying at anchor at Point Dague 23
Tuesday 23 fine the larboard watch ashore on
liberty larboard watch employed stowing down
water middle and last rang the starboard watch
on liberty so ends

Wednesday 24 Dan in Gal commences fine the starboard
watch employed painting the larboard watch in
fore part fine the larboard watch in
sent the boat ashore for the liberty men
middle and last part fine the larboard watch
went on liberty sent the boat ashore
in fore part for refusing duty so ends

Thursday 25 commences fine the larboard watch
on liberty at sunset sent the boat
ashore for the liberty men middle
and last part fine all hands employed
getting off water so ends

Friday 26 George Smith commences fine all hands
employed getting water at 12 P.M.
look the ship on board and hoisted
the middle part fine last part the same
the starboard watch went on liberty larboard watch
employed stowing of the fore hold so ends
several English merchantmen in the
harbor and steamers being so
