

February 1850  
Saturday 2 commences fine with light breeze  
from N.E. steering S.W. at 4 PM set  
sea watches for the night middle & last  
part fine with light breezes steering S.W.  
so ends lat 5.09 long 48.34 E

Sunday 3 commences fine with light breeze  
from N.E. steering S.W. under all sail middle  
& last fine with the wind from N.E. & S.  
steering by the wind heading N.W. under  
all sail so ends lat 4.30 S long 47.54 E

Monday 4 commences fine with moderate  
breezes from N.E. & S. steering by the wind  
heading N.W. under all sail at 5 PM so  
aboard to the Whitehouse middle & last part  
fine steering N by S so ends lat 4.26 S  
long 48.58 E

Tuesday 5 commences fine with moderate breezes  
from N.E. & S. steering N by S carrying all sail  
middle & last part the same steered West  
so ends lat 4.20 S long 44.25 E

Wednesday 6 commences fine with brisk breezes  
from N.E. steering N under all sail middle  
& last the same steering N by S so ends  
lat 4.22 S long 42.31 E

The barbare has 8 oars out

Thursday 7 commences cloudy with light breeze  
from N.E. steering N by S under all sail at  
sunset took in the light sails and took reef  
and listed for 4 mainsail left to the wind  
to E.S. middle & last part strong breezes at  
daylight set for 4 spanker & 4 jib so ends

Friday 8 commences with strong breezes from  
N.E. steering by the wind heading E.S. at  
sunset took in for 4 spanker middle &  
last part the same at daylight set the spanker  
and jib so ends

Saturday 9 commences with strong breezes from  
N.E. steering by the wind heading E.S. at sunset  
took in for 4 spanker middle & last part  
fine with light winds at daylight  
made sail struck the masts out set the  
main topgallant sail jib & spanker so ends

Sunday 10 commences with moderate winds  
from N.E. & S. steering by the wind heading  
E at sunset took in sail for the night  
and wore ship to the Whitehouse middle &  
last fine with moderate breezes at day  
light made sail and steered to south so ends  
lat 4.00 S long 46.31 E

Monday 11 commences fine steering by the  
wind of E at sunset took in sail for the  
night and steered to the N.W. at daylight  
made all sail and steered South so ends  
so ends
