

Brown bound towards Hebe

Wednesday 6 commences here with light breeze from NNE heading to W at sunset backed to the East and set so watches for the night and E wind the same under all sail heading to E so ends lat 03 45 N long 52 28 E

Thursday 7 commences here with moderate breeze from N heading East under all sail at 8 AM backed to the N at 6 PM backed again the wind coming from NE at 7 AM so a sail to leeward so ends lat 03 45 N long 53 53 E

Friday 8 commences here with light winds from N heading E by S by the wind under all sail the above mentioned sail in sight middle of the day the same steering to the E under all sail so ends lat 03 47 N long 54 37 E

Saturday 9 commences here with light winds from the N steering by the wind under all sail at 8 AM at 8 PM backed to S W wind at 11 AM saw ships to East the island at noon in sight

Sunday 10 commences here with light breeze from N heading E by the wind under all sail heading S W distance 20 miles out into the open and saw the anchors middle and last corner maybe 3 or 4 other Islands in sight bearing S by W distance 30 miles so ends lat (3 44 N)

Monday 11 commences near the Gard of Hebe in sight bearing S by W distance 20 miles at last the same the islands in sight bearing N distance 20 miles so ends lat 3 43

Tuesday 12 commences here and near the Islands bearing S by W distance 17 miles heading to the Eastward under all sail middle of last line with light breeze from N steering South the same in sight bearing S S W distance 8 miles so ends

Wednesday 13 commences with light breeze from N steering S by W under all sail bearing S S W distance 8 miles middle and last part fine steering in for Hebe so ends

Thursday 14 commences with light breeze from N steering in for the harbor at 4 PM let go anchor in the mouth of the harbor being nearly the bark alto of George Porter & Co. at 11 AM she came up and went in to the harbor and came to anchor the captain went ashore so ends

Friday 15 commences laying at anchor in Hebe the captain ashore middle of day & rain at daylight broke out the rain hat for water cask and rafted them I sent them ashore and felled part of them so ends
