Sunday 30 commences fine with moderate  
breeze from ESE heading ~~to~~ <sup>to</sup> under all  
sail as a sail to the leeward and one  
sulfherbolan middle & last five  
were steep overall times  
took in sail for the night

Sunday 31 March 1850 April 1 1850  
with variable winds heading S & E se  
was at sunset took in sail for  
the night middle & last part came se  
finback so ends

Monday April 1 commences fine and  
calm middle & last part light breeze  
from SSE heading S W se finback  
so ends

Tuesday 2 commences with light breeze  
from SSE heading to S W se finback at  
sunset took in sail for the night and  
was round to ESE middle & last five  
employed mending the fore topside were  
shut to S W se ends lat 44 35 S 27 E

Wednesday 3 commences with light breeze  
from SE heading S W se aboard at  
anchor at one of the African Islands  
finish and bent the main top galant  
sail and fore topside middle & last the  
same heading to S E se ends

Thursday 4 commences fine with light breeze  
from ESE heading to S E under all  
sail at 10 ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~last~~ <sup>last</sup> ~~part~~ <sup>part</sup> ~~came~~ <sup>came</sup> ~~se~~ <sup>se</sup>  
finback under all sail so ends
