Thursday 11 commences fine under all sail the wind from the N.W. cleared S at sunset lifted 1/2 heading S.W. middle & last the same last fine with light breeze from N steering S under all sail lat 43.18 S long 56 02 E

Friday 12 commences fine with light winds from N steering S under all sail at sunset took in sail and luffed to heading S.W. middle & last the same at daylight made sail and tacked ship to the S.W. so ends

Saturday 13 commences fine with light winds from N heading W at sunset took in sail at sunset took in sail and luffed to heading N.W. by E middle Steered by this wind heading N at daylight made sail and took heading S.W. at sunset the St. Peter's a. whaling so ends

Sunday 14 commences fine with light winds from N steering S took St. Peter's & made sail 1/2 S 1/2 S heading N.W. by E so ends
