Saturday 18 commences fine with light
winds from S.E. steering by the E. East.
all hands employed mending sail at sunset
finished both in the light sails under
and last the same all hands employed on
boarding and mending new sails so ends

Sunday 19 commences with light breeze from
S.E. heading to the Eastward at sunset
look in the light sails mid & last
piece under all sail heading Eastward.
so ends

Monday 20 commences with light breeze
from S.E. heading to the Eastward.
under all sail at 4 PM tacked to the
S.W. mid & last the same all hands
employed mending sails heading to the S.
so ends lat 3.24 S long 53.42 W

Tuesday 21 commences with light breeze from
E.S.E. heading S. under all sail all hands
employed mending sail - se grasspass mid &
& last line at 8 PM were shift to Eastward
at 3 PM were shift to South at daylight
made sail all Watch employed mending sail
so ends

Wednesday 22 commences fine steering by the
wind to S.W. all Watch employ mending sails at
sunset took in sail for the night mid

Brace Off Mayne Banks 1850 May 22
and last part fine at 8 PM tacked
to the Eastward so ends

Thursday 23 commences fine with light wind
from S.E. steering by the wind to East
at 4 PM se grasspass at sunset took in
the light sails all hands mending sail mid
& last piece under all sail the watch mending
sails the Island of Chabty in sight
bearing S by W 30 miles long 55 38 E

Friday 24 commences fine with light
winds from S.E. heading to Eastward
Chabty in sight bearing S.W. 1/2 S at
sunset took in the fore topgallant sail
mid and last piece at daylight made
sail at 9 PM tacked to S.W. so ends
lat 3.24 S long 55 38

Saturday 25 commences fine with light
winds from S.E. heading S.W. by the wind
at sunset took in the fore topgallant sail
mid & last piece at daylight tacked to the
S.W. so ends lat 3.30 S

Sunday 26 commences fine with from S.E.
heading S.W. at 2 PM se asail to the
windward at 4 PM sighted Cook
Island at 5 PM gamed with the barburn
of New London 21 mounds out 400 species
