

68 Middle & last line showing to Eastward at 7 AM took to SW the caribbees in sight so white water sounds

Monday 27 commences fine with light winds from S & E heading to S & E at 2 PM took ship to Eastward the caribbees in sight middle & last line so finbacks & sail middle heading to the E last to S & W so ends lat 3.30 S long 56.27

Tuesday 28 commences fine with light winds from S heading to S so finbacks at sunset took in the light sails middle & last square & ran at 1 AM were ship to South east sound

Wednesday 29 commences calm and rainy at dusk took in sail and up the fore top sail heading to the Eastward middle & last - show winds at daylight set whole top sails & top gale sail heading to the Eastward so ends

Thursday the 30 commences cloudy with light winds from S & E heading to S & E at sunset took in the light sails and were ship to S W middle fine heading the Eastward at daylight made sail and took to S W & finbacks so ends lat 3.32 S long 57.37

69 Off Sea Shells Islands June 1840

Friday 31 commences fine with strong winds from S E heading S W at 2 PM took in the top sails & sail to the windward at sunset took in sail for the night - were ship to the Eastward at 2 AM were moved to S W at sunrise made all sail so ends lat 3.42 S long 56.53

Saturday June 1 8.50 commences fine with moderate breezes from S & E heading S W at sunset took in the light sails & sails raised the top sails middle and last fine with light breezes from S S W heading S & S so ends

Sunday 2 commences fine with light winds from S heading S & E at sunset took in the light sails & the spanker were ship to Westward at 12 AM were ship to S E at daylight were moved to West & made sail so ends

Monday 3 commences fine with light winds from S heading West & a finback at sunset were ship to S & E and took in sail for the night - middle fine at 2 AM were moved to S W at daylight made all sail and cleared at 5 AM lat 3.42 S long 56.53
