

70 Tuesday 4 commences fine with moderate breezes from S steering N^W by W under all sail at sunsett took in sail for the night and luffed to the S. C. middle & last part fine at daylight made sail and tacked to W so ends lat 31 14 E long 55 47 E

Wednesday 5 commences fine the same from S & E steering to the N^W under all sail at sunsett took in the night sails for 12 wore ship to West at daylight made sail so ends lat 34 39 E long 54 39 E

Thursday 6 commences fine with light winds from S & E heading N^W by W at sunsett took in the fore top sail middle & last fine heading to W by N at daylight made sail so ends lat 35 21 E long 54 21 E

Friday 7 commences fine with light winds from S & E heading N^W by W at sunsett took in the fore top sail middle & last fine so ends lat 36 21 E long 54 21 E

Saturday 8 commences fine with light breezes from S & E heading N^W by W spoke the bark batholomew a bar 36 mounts out - 14.00 spun 4 96. who at middle & last the same at daylight made all sail heading E at sail in sight 3.21 E

Monday 9 commences squally with light winds from S & E heading N^W by W under all sail at sunsett took in sail for the night middle & last fine weather at sunsett made all sail heading S^W by S so ends lat 35 25 E long 54 25 E

Tuesday 10 commences with strong breeze from S & E under all sail at sunsett took in sail for the night middle & last fine weather at sunsett made all sail heading S^W by S so ends lat 33 36 E long 53 36 E

Wednesday 11 commences fine with strong winds from S & E heading S^W by W under all sail at sunsett took in sail for the night middle and squally under sail at 11.10 wore ship to West & till wore to the W so ends

Thursday 12 commences squally with strong winds from S & E heading N^W by W under stable water top sails were set & tacked at sunsett took in sail middle & last the same at daylight set gill & spinnaker so ends lat 35 25 E long 51 23 E

Friday 13 commences with strong wind from S & E heading to the S^W at 5.00 saw sperm whales at 3 1/2 PM burned without success came aboard and tacked to E shortened sail for the night
