

78 Saturday 13 commences fine with light
breeze from S heading to S E at the light
sails made & last the same at 9 AM took
in the right sails making S E by wind
tacked to the S W at 13.57 N long 44.35

Sunday 14 commences fine with light breeze
from S heading to the S W the watch improved under
the 1st watch & last the same working
to South under all sail so ends lat 14.23
long 44.29

Monday 15 commences with a fine breeze
to S E heading to the S W under all
sail middle light winds from S E heading
to the S E last the wind from S heading
to S E the watch improved under all sail
lat 14.22 long 44.29

Tuesday 16 commences fine with light breeze
from S E heading to S W at sunset the
hull to S W & tacked to S E the watch
improved under all sail & last the same
at the island at daylight under all sail
lat 18 miles so ends lat 14.22 long 44.29

Wednesday 17 commences fine with light breeze
and calmer weather the 1st watch in
sight bearing S E last 17 miles at
sunset took in sail for the night
middle and the same at daylight
so a sail so ends

79 Fine breeze in the M. combes (Chen)
Thursday 18 commences with light breeze from
Southward spoke the Bark Bethelmore
forward of main Berd with 13 hundred
Barrel & 1 hundred barrels middle &
last the same stores that the land in
sight so ends

Friday 19 commences fine & calm to
work sitting up Rigging at sunset so
grasshoppers took in the fore topgallant sail
middle and last the same so a sail
so ends

Saturday 20 commences fine with light
breeze from S E heading to S W at
11 AM spoke and jammed with 26
barrels 26 out with 400 spinn
to work sitting up Rigging middle & last
light breeze from S heading to S E
tacked all sail by close reefed main top sail
and tacked to the East at daylight so a sail
middle & sparker to work
very even lat 15.56 N long 43.35 E

Sunday 21 commences fine with light breeze
from S heading to S W under all
sail top sail goes 1st & sparker middle
steared at 1/4 E at daylight made sail &
steared to S E so ends lat 14.53 S
long 43.17 E
