

84 Bruce Off Adabra Island Aug 1850
Thursday 8 commences fine with light
breezes from ESE heading to South
West so blackfish at sunset took in
sail for the night middle & last part
light was steering N by E sent the main
top sail on down and repaired it so ended
Tott 09.30 S commences

Friday 9 commences fine with light
SSE steering N by E so blackfish & grampus
to work mending the main sheet at 4 PM
finishes and hauled it at sunset took in
sail for the night middle and last the
same at daylight made all sail so
the Bark Georg Washington New Bedford
and gambled with her 24 hours out 800
spinn so ends

Saturday 10 commences fine the wind from
SSE heading E by N gambling with
the Georg Washington at sunset took in
sail for the night middle and last the
same the Georg Washington in sight
so finbacks so ends

Sunday 11 commences fine with light
ares from SSE heading E by N so
spouts to windward took in the fore
top galant sail hoisting E middle and last
the same at 2 AM tacked to the S at 10
AM tacked to E the Georg Washington in

85 Monday 12 commences fine with light winds
from SSE heading to Eastward under all sail
the Georg Washington in sight at sunset
took in the fore top galant sail middle
and last the same at 3 AM tacked to
south Westward at 9 AM tacked to East
so ends

Tuesday 13 commences fine with light
winds from SE heading to Eastward
at sunset took in sail for the night
middle & last the same at 7 AM tacked
ship to the South so ends Tott 09.20 S
by compass 42 39 E

Wednesday 14 commences fine with moderate
breezes from ESE heading to South at
dark took in sail for the night middle &
last part the same heading SE West so
the Bark Georg Washington so ends Tott 09.40

Thursday 15 commences fine with light ares
from SE heading SEW the Georg Washington
in sight at sunset tacked ESE middle
& last the same at 7 AM tacked to
SEW so 2 sails to the Windward so
ends

Friday 16 commences fine with light ares
from SE heading SEW at 3.30 AM
the wind halled to SE & tacked to East
sail in sight middle & last tacked to SE
sail at daylight made sail heading ESE
