

At 5 AM tacked to the S. by the Caroline in sight Mobat Baring N by S 25 still dist-
so ends

Thursday 8 commences fire with light braces from S by W heading N by W under all sail at 2 PM tacked to the S so several finbacks at sunset took in the foretopgallant sail Mobat Baring N by S distance 12 miles middle & last the same at 7 AM tacked to N the above mentioned sail in sight so mobat head so ends

Wednesday 9 commences fire with light braces from S by W heading to the Westward at 2 PM were still & steered to S by E mobat head baring N by S distance 9 miles middle & last the same steering by the wind to S so ends lat 16 19 N

Thursday 10 commences again heading to the S under all sail the watch employed sitting now barons to the boat so finbacked middle & last the same at 4 AM were ship to N by E so ends lat 16 20 N

Friday 11 commences with light arcs from N heading to N under all sail so grasspass & finback at sunset took in the light sails middle & last the same at daylight made all sail light arcs from S by heading N by S so mobat baring N by W distance 25 miles so ends

End

Saturday 12 commences with light arcs from N heading N by S so a finback at sunset took in the light sails fore & spanker mainsail mobat head baring N by S distance 20 miles at 7 PM were ship to S middle & last the same at 2 AM were ship to N by E at daylight so mobat head and stood in for the shore so ends lat 17 00 N

Sunday 13 commences with light arcs from N heading to N by W under all sail mobat baring N by S distance 22 miles at sunset took in the light sails main sail fore & spanker & were ship to S by middle and last the same at 4 AM were ship to S by at daylight made all sail so humpbacks so ends

Monday 14 commences with light arcs & commences heading to N by W under all sail at 4 PM the humped round to S by S heading N by S by the wind at sunset took in the light sails mobat in sight baring N by S distance 25 miles middle & last the same heading to S under all sail so humpbacks so ends 16 34 N

Tuesday 15 commences fire with light winds from N heading to the South at 1 PM tacked to N by E distance 30 miles middle & last the same at 9 PM tacked to S by S at 11 PM tacked to S by S made all sail so finbacks so ends lat 17 00 N

Wednesday 16 commences with light arcs from N heading to N under all sail mobat baring N by S distance 10 miles so several foves in shore at 2 PM tacked to S by so several humpbacks middle & last part when the watch employed striking heads so ends

Thursday 17 commences with fine weather & even all sail set the watch employed striking the heads at sunset took in the light sails middle & last the same so finbacks the sailing sight so ends
